TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DENTON COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 6 AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 49, Texas Water Code, that the Board of Directors of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 6 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 19, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. at 2650 FM 407 E, Suite 125, Bartonville, Texas,** for the following purpose

1. Determination of Quorum and Call to Order (KS);
2. Pledges of Allegiance to United States Flag and Texas Flag (KS);
3. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any items brought before them at this time. Citizen’s comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Directors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. Please complete a Public Input Form if you desire to address the Board. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof (KS);
4. Consent Items (KS):
